Short Catechesis

CAN SOMEONE GO TO CONFESSION ONLINE?

No, the church does not permit online confession. The Sacrament of Reconciliation requires the penitent to confess personally to a priest who is physically present to listen, give counsel, assign a penance and pronounce absolution. Online or phone confession is not valid except that a priest may offer spiritual guidance. But sacramental absolution must be given in person.

WHO ARE THOSE QUALIFIED TO RECEIVE THE SACRAMENTS OF RECONCILIATION

Confession is a beautiful sacrament in which Christ forgives sins and restores us to friendship with God. Those qualified to go to the confession are baptized Catholic who have reached the age of reason, are sorry for their sins, sincerely desires God's forgiveness with the intention to avoid sin and amend their lives. Your sins are forgiven through the mercy of Jesus Christ.

DOES GOING TO CONFESSION AND FORGETTING TO DO PENANCE HAVE CONSEQUENCES?

If you make a sincere confession and receive absolution your sins are forgiven. However, you should complete the penance the priest gives you as soon as reasonably possible. If you forget and are unable to do it, it does not cancel your absolution, but you should fulfil the penance later. Deliberately refusing to do your penance shows a lack of obedience and gratitude towards God's mercy.

ALGUIEN PUEDE CONFESARSE EN LÍNEA?

No, la Iglesia no permite la confesión en línea. El Sacramento de la Reconciliación requiere que el

penitente se confiese personalmente con un sacerdote que esté físicamente presente para escuchar, dar consejo, imponer una penitencia y pronunciar la absolución. La confesión en línea o por teléfono no es válida, excepto que un sacerdote puede ofrecer orientación espiritual. Pero la absolución sacramental debe darse en persona.

QUIÉNES ESTÁN CAPACITADOS PARA RECIBIR LOS SACRAMENTOS DE LA RECONCILIACIÓN?

La confesión es un hermoso sacramento en el que Cristo perdona los pecados y nos restaura a la amistad con Dios. Quienes están capacitados para confesarse son los católicos bautizados que han alcanzado la edad de la razón, están arrepentidos de sus pecados, desean sinceramente el perdón de Dios con la intención de evitar el pecado y enmendar sus vidas. Tus pecados son perdonados por la misericordia de Jesucristo.

TIENE CONSECUENCIAS IR A CONFESARSE Y OLVIDARSE DE CUMPLIR LA PENITENCIA?

Si haces una confesión sincera y recibes la absolución, tus pecados son perdonados. Sin embargo, debes cumplir la penitencia que te da el sacerdote tan pronto como sea razonablemente posible. Si te olvidas y no puedes cumplirla, esto no anula tu absolución, pero debes cumplir la penitencia más adelante. Negarse deliberadamente a cumplir la penitencia demuestra una falta de obediencia y gratitud hacia la misericordia de Dios.
