REFLECTION

Today's first reading invites us to reflect on a powerful truth: when we make room in our lives for God, he transforms the way we live and how we love.

It's the 9th century, and Israel is spiritually unstable, with Elisha traveling from place to place. There came a woman from Shunem who recognized something others might have missed. She saw in Elisha a holy man of God. Her response is very surprising. She does not offer a one-time kindness but creates a space for him – a small room where he can rest whenever he passes by. Her hospitality is intentional, generous, and rooted in faith. This simple act opened a door for God to act in her life.

In a world often driven by gain and recognition, her quietness stands out. When Elisha wishes to reward her, she asks for nothing. She is content with her life. Yet God sees deeper than outward contentment. Beneath her silence lies inner longing. She has no child, and through Elisha, God promised her a son. Her reaction is deeply human. Her hesitation indicates she is afraid to believe.

Hope can be risky, especially when it has been held for so long. But God's promise proves faithful. This passage gently reminds us that God notices a lot. An act of kindness done in sincerity never goes unrewarded.

The Shunamite woman teaches us that faith is not always loud. It is found in a small, consistent gesture of love. We are invited to live like her, recognize God in others and make space for them in the ordinary and to trust that even the unspoken desires of our hearts are known to God.

La lectura de hoy nos invita a reflexionar sobre una verdad poderosa: cuando hacemos espacio para-Dios en nuestras vidas, él transforma la manera en que vivimos y cómo amamos.

Es el siglo IX, e Israel es espiritualmente inestable, con Eliseo viajando de un lugar a otro. En la primera lectura, aparece una mujer de Sunén

que reconoce algo que otros podrían haber pasado por alto. Ella vio en Eliseo a un santo hombre de Dios. Su respuesta es muy sorprendente. No ofrece una sola muestra de bondad, sino que crea un espacio para él: una pequeña habitación donde pueda descansar cada vez que pase por allí. Su hospitalidad es intencional, generosa y está arraigada en la fe. Este sencillo acto abrió una puerta para que Dios actuara en su vida.

Dios ve más profundamente que la satisfacción exterior. Debajo de su silencio hay un anhelo interior. No tiene hijos y, por medio de Eliseo, Dios le promete un hijo. Ella duda y teme creer. La esperanza puede ser arriesgada, especialmente cuando se ha guardado durante tanto tiempo. Pero la promesa de Dios demuestra ser fiel.

Este pasaje nos recuerda suavemente que Dios percibe mucho más de lo que vemos. Un acto de bondad realizado con sinceridad nunca queda sin recompensa. La fe puede no ser ruidosa, pero se manifiesta en un pequeño y constante gesto de amor. Confía en Dios, porque incluso tus deseos no expresados le son conocidos.
