REFLECTION

Today the Church celebrates a two-fold feast of The Most Holy Trinity and the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary – May 31. The Holy Trinity is by far the most complex mystery found within the Deposit of Faith held by the Church. Above all other creatures, the Blessed Virgin Mary enjoys the fullness of relation to the three Persons of the Holy Trinity, as Daughter, Mother, and Spouse.

The Annunciation by the Archangel Gabriel to the Blessed Virgin not only announced the Incarnation to the world but also revealed the entire mystery of the Trinity. In the Annunciation the Father is revealed by the Angel that He has chosen Mary as the Mother of His Son and that He has blessed her above all others. Secondly, Jesus the second person of the Trinity is announced by the Angel as a holy Child from God. In addition, it is by the Holy Spirit that Mary shall conceive and bear the Son of God, who is God incarnate.

The relationship between Mary and the Holy Trinity is easily understood because it is through Mary that God wishes to bring the Font of Grace into the world. It is fitting that the Spouse of the Holy Spirit, the Mother of God Incarnate, and the Chosen Daughter of God the Father should be included in the participation of the Trinity.

Little wonder that Mary travels a “hill country” to share the joy revealed to her by the invocation of the Holy Trinity with Elizabeth her cousin as the feast of today depicts. In visiting Elizabeth shows that gratitude is the language of a heart that recognizes God’s goodness. It is the ability to see blessings even in ordinary moments and to trust that God remains faithful in every season of life. Mary teaches us this beautiful attitude through her life of praise and thanksgiving. In her visit, her heart overflowed with gratitude, and she sang the hymn we know as the Magnificat: My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my savior” (Lk. 1:46-47).

Mary did not focus on her limitations or fears; instead, she recognized the greatness of God working in her life. She understood that every grace, every blessing, and every calling comes from God’s loving kindness. True gratitude is not limited to moments

when life is easy. Mary praised God even amid uncertainty. She did not know all that her vocation would entail, yet her heart remained filled with trust and thanksgiving.

Often, we become discouraged because we focus more on what is missing than on what has been given. We complain about delays, burdens, disappointments, or unanswered prayers, forgetting the countless ways God quietly sustains us each day. But gratitude changes the heart. It transforms anxiety into trust, comparison into contentment, and discouragement into hope. Thus, with Mary we are called to recognize grace even in small things or show of kindness from God and move away to share that gift or favor with one another.

The feast of the trinity (three person in one God) and the visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary invite us to cultivate a spirit of thanksgiving, to see life not as entitlement but as gift to be shared. No matter what you are facing, there is always something for which to thank God.

Mary's caring for her Son and her discipleship in visiting Elizabeth, her keeping and pondering all his words in her heart, enable her to 'penetrate more and more deeply into an understanding of the Trinity: of the Father whose daughter she is, of the Son whose mother and spiritual bride she is, and of the Spirit whose vessel she is.
